



### **1** Introduction

The signature of this Memorandum of Understanding among DITRAMA consortium aims to improve their exchange of information, communication and collaboration regarding the vocational education and training activities related to digital transformation management and related fields. Partners confirm their interest in other learning contents and further development of skills, knowledge and competence related to the furniture or transversal sectors, innovative methodologies and new technologies used. This agreement enters into force only when and if the VET provider partner organize and hold a training course related to the DITRAMA training materials and/or on-line training course.

Partners also believe that it is essential to strengthen the link between innovation and industry and to facilitate permeability between vocational training and industries.

In order to improve the quality of VET offer and facilitate the mobility of workers across of the EU, this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) confirms that each signatory organization:

- is aware of the current gap in skills, knowledge and competence of the workers and other target groups in relation to digital transformation management.
- is aware of the importance of trying to monitor when new gaps emerge and identify the proper methodology and field of training that can reduce them.
- aims to reduce existing gaps through the new joint curriculum of the Digital Transformation Manager and the related training course created.
- commit to recognize this training course and the related ECVET points for all the learners that successfully pass the related tests in entities part of this consortium or that undersigned this agreement.

The validity period of this MoU is established from the date of signature for a minimum of five years.

This Memorandum of Understanding can be signed also by other entities sharing the same interest and view about the importance of VET in supporting workers, companies and all industrial stakeholders. They will commit to recognized the DITRAMA joint curriculum, the related training course and ECVET points for all the learners that successfully passed the related tests in one or more of the entities subscribing this MoU.


